Upon finishing the project, vessels can leave the U.S. without the obligation to pay duties or taxes. The FTZ designation also facilitates operational flexibility for vessels, allowing them to enter and exit the zone as needed. This flexibility is particularly advantageous for accommodating owners' trips and yacht charters.
